As well as the laser tag, visitors can explore themed adventure play areas, a magical woodland, and a huge interactive indoor playground.

Stockeld Park also specializes in Adventure Trips for schools. At Stockeld Park, they know that giving children the opportunity to explore in the outdoor environment has so many benefits, from learning and creativity to well-being and independence.

According to the Express, Stockeld Park is a little different to most other amusement parks in that significant sections of it are indoors, meaning that come rain or shine everyone's having a good time.

(The Cobra Tagger is "weather-resistant" so you can play laser tag in showers and rain.)
